

Installing Stainless Steel Gate with Glass Insert

Overview

Below are instructions for how to install a Stainless Steel Gate with Glass Insert. The gate is usually made of four 90-degree elbows, four tubes riveted in their middle, and 4 glass clamps.

It is important to install your gate/posts before ordering your glass for the most accurate measurements.

***Caution:** Wear protective ANSI approved safety glass, working gloves and breathing mask all the times.

Tools Needed

- 1) A Piece of cloth or styrofoam bag
- 2) Rubber Mallet
- 3) Glass Clamps
- 4) Install the glass

Installation Instructions

- 1) Using a mallet, tap in gently the 90 elbows to the tubing while making sure that the rivets are facing inward. Cover the area with a cloth or styrofoam bag to protect the area where you are tapping.
- 2) Install the Glass Clamps.
- 3) Do final small adjustments to the tubing elbow direction and Glass Clamps.
- 4) Take measurements and order the glass 1/8 smaller than the measured distance
